



**A Somerset windmill?**

This illustration of a windmill typical of Somerset is by W.J. Müller, though it is unsigned. The original measures 14ins. by 10 1/4 ins. It is owned by Bradford Art Galleries and Museums; they sent a copy to Francis Greenacre, of Bristol City Art Gallery, who dates it to about 1832.

It is inscribed (apparently in the hand of the Rev. James Bulwer): Long Ashton ... top of Clevedon Hill, Pencil and watercolour.

There is no known record of a mill on a site which could be described as the Rev. Bulwer has done, but there is a possibility that it stood near the present Bristol airport at Lulsgate.
